## CALL FOR STUDENT ART SUBMISSIONS Grades 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>

### **Deadline: December 23<sup>rd</sup>**

Students in grades 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> are invited to submit work for the Prospect.2 student exhibit and digital/sound installation inspired by the work of Prospect.2 artists, William Pope.L and Dan Tague.

Students should submit 1-2 digital photographs in response to the questions:

- What is uniquely New Orleans?
- Why do you love New Orleans?

Students should submit photography-based artwork. Students can manipulate photographs using text or other materials. Digital images of the work should be submitted in jpeg format to [education@prospectneworleans.org](mailto:education@prospectneworleans.org) by ***Friday, December 23<sup>rd</sup>***. Students selected for the exhibit would be notified on Thursday, December 29<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

All student images will be incorporated into a collaborative digital work, accompanied by a sound installation created by students at Lusher High School in collaboration with Prospect.2 artist Dan Tague. The exhibition will be mounted at the Jazz and Heritage Foundation's gallery at 1205 N. Rampart Street. An opening reception for participating student artists will be hosted by Prospect.2 on January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2011.
